If I am to acknowledge God, I must acknowledge incorporeal God, and that means not only that I cannot embrace God in a figure or form, but I cannot even embrace It in a mental image. I dare not even name It because if I call It "Spirit" or "Mind," I have made an image of what I think God is. Even if I call It "Love," I have made an image. . . The only way in which I can know God is by knowing that I cannot know God, that God cannot be embraced in my mind, and that God is. Once you acknowledge that God *is*, you are inferentially declaring that God is infinity, God is omniscience, God is omnipotence, God is omnipresence. . . All you will even know about God is the word *I*.

God Is

I say, "God is." I not only say it, but more than that, I sit back and let God be God to me, and not merely a form of worship in my mind. I am finished with "God is" in half a second, and get back into my silence where I open myself to God: "Speak, Lord; for thy servant heareth.". . . No matter how many words one uses or how many acts he performs, he has done no more than acknowledge God, and I have done that.

I said before that the earth is really heaven, only seen through finite sense, seen through a "glass darkly." Well, inasmuch as you will never see it any other way than that with your eyes, why not acknowledge it and sit back with your eyes closed and let your spiritual sense reveal the harmony of being to you.

You see, since our premise is that all action is mind action and God is the only mind, everything that is appearing to you is the activity of God. So what we are doing now is not overcoming error, but rightly interpreting that picture before us...Still it is quite in order to say, "How about interpreting this for me and letting me see it as it is?" It is perfectly all right to say that to God—no resistance there, you see; no acknowledgment that it is an error to be overcome. No acknowledgment that there is a sinner to be reformed; no acknowledgment that there is a lack or limitation that must be met.

Jesus said, "I of mine own self can do nothing, the Father within doeth the works." And I do not mean there were two people—Jesus and the Father. I recognize that when he used the term Father he meant the divine Essence or Presence or Law of the infinite. That is what he meant by the Father, and so do we. In acknowledging God, or a divine Father, we are not acknowledging some person or even some being or power outside ourselves. That would be two-ness, that would be duality—and that would be fatal.

As long as I acknowledge an *I*, my Self, as long as I acknowledge an invisible and incorporeal mind as my instrument, which I keep filled with truth, if there is anything wrong with my brain or my body, it will be corrected. How? I know the truth in and through my mind, and that truth which I know in my mind becomes the very essence and substance of my body, because mind is the substance of the physical sense of body. . . Therefore, whatever I impart to my mind, the body shows forth.

You cannot come to the spiritual throne until you love God supremely, and you are loving God supremely only if you acknowledge God as the only Power.

Discovering Infinity Within

As we close our eyes and turn within, we find ourselves in a blackness, a darkness, but the very place where that darkness is is our means of access to Infinity. In our acknowledgment of this we are ready for an impartation to come to us. It does not come from without. It comes from within, and it does not come from anyone to us: it comes from the Self of us and to us. . . We bring it about by our turning within and realizing: *Consciousness is what I am, and through Consciousness, I have access to the kingdom of God, to Infinity*.

We might as well face the problem or it will continue. The reason the law of cause and effect continues to operate in our consciousness is because we give power to this law. Eventually we must come back to, "No, God has given me dominion, and there is no power outside of me." . . . So let us begin to face our problems without a desire to get rid of them, without a fear of them. I'm going to acknowledge there is an error and I'm looking at it, but there is a solution. With some realization of truth, we are finding error doesn't exist. . . The problem must be licked through understanding.

Always remember that it is the acknowledgment that brings the experience. If I acknowledge a sufficiency of God's grace in this moment, I have it! If I do not acknowledge it, I virtually deny it. . . You must be a law unto yourself by the truth you know and, if you are not as yet aware of the omnipresence of a divine grace sufficient unto this moment, become aware of it and live with it. Then you will realize how your life is lived not by might and not by power, but by grace.

Listening. . . is an acknowledgment that it is not the human sense of I who has power or who can bring health to anyone. But the consciousness which I am, expressing itself, reveals itself as harmony in any and every form.

Instead of blaming another, we must make the acknowledgment, here and now, that some false state of being, some false state of thought or act within our own being, has drawn this [terrible wrong] to us, and had it not come through that particular individual, it most certainly would have come through some other, since the experience *had* to come to us.

To admit a lack is to deprive ourselves of the abundance that is already ours, and by admitting the lack, we deprive ourselves even of the little that we may have at hand. To acknowledge that we already have all that the Father has, whether or not it is visible or immediately available at the moment, is to acknowledge the truth of "Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine," and that is enough to enable us immediately to start giving, spending, and serving, and in that release the flow of supply would begin.

Every time you think thoughts of hopelessness and despair, it is as if you are acknowledging that you are a branch cut off from the vine, and the vine from the husbandsman, and that you cannot reach either; yet all of the time *it* is right here where you are. *It* is within you, and *it* is *Omnipresence*.

Spiritual Fruitage Through Understanding No Escape From Omnipresence

Perhaps you have believed that there is some incurable disease and that this proves the absence of God. Do not believe it. The very belief in the absence of God perpetuates the belief in the presence and power of disease. Acknowledge Omnipresence, even if you are making your bed in hell: *Here where I am, God is. In spite of my sin, in spite of my disease, in spite of my lack or limitation, in spite of my unhappiness, God is omnipresent.*

SHOWING FORTH THE PRESENCE OF GOD

God Alone Is Power Importance Of Listening

Instead of persisting in a battle between good health and bad health, between goodness and badness, between abundance and lack, give up this struggle. Acknowledge here and now that you are not under the law of cause and effect. At this instant of accepting your divine sonship, you are under grace. You do not believe that the son of God is under the law of cause and effect. You do not believe that the son of God can be influenced by human motives, human beliefs, or human powers.

Our work is to recognize IS

Once you begin to acknowledge God's presence, the mental strain is lifted, because you do not have to think thoughts to make something happen, not even right thoughts or good thoughts. The moment you realize that God is infinite, you learn that good thoughts are not any more helpful than bad thoughts are harmful. They are just not power because God alone is power. You can think two times two are four, but that is true whether you think it or not. You can think thoughts about life being eternal, but such thoughts are not power; they do not make it so. Life was eternal in the beginning before ever time began. You can think that someone you know is spiritual, but that will not do the person any good: he was spiritual from the beginning. . In the beginning with God, the Word became flesh, and every person is that. Thinking, these things does not make them true. Thinking such thoughts has the value of reminding us of that which forever has been.

The allness of God is made manifest as the allness of the son. God is both the Father and the Son: God, the Father, knowing the truth, and the truth will make you free, free from discordant appearances or experiences. But the truth you must know is that nothing can be added to you, that you cannot get anything, you cannot achieve anything, and you cannot demonstrate anything because all that the Father has is already yours. The life of God is your life; therefore, your life is eternal. The mind of God is your mind; therefore, you have infinite intelligence. God, the Soul, is your individual soul; therefore, you are as pure as God. Outward appearances have nothing to do with it. Outward beliefs about yourself or others have nothing to do with it. Outward actions in contradiction to that have nothing to do with it. In your spiritual identity, you are the full Christ or son of God, endowed with the power to multiply loaves and fishes, heal the sick, raise the dead, and open the eyes of the blind. Your acknowledgment of this is knowing the truth that will make you free from human beliefs, appearances, theories, and rumors.

When you acknowledge that you lack and have not, you have not only made this true for yourself today but much more true tomorrow, because from that moment the little that you have will be taken from you.

You must cast your bread upon the water if you want it to come back to you, and you must acknowledge that you already have within your consciousness the allness of God. . . If you do not acknowledge that God's wisdom is your wisdom, you will never be able to open your mouth to utter truth. If you do not acknowledge that God's supply is yours, you will never be able to open your pocketbook and let the substance of the millions and millions of dollars that are in your consciousness flow out. You do not see them because they appear only in the order of your use of them.

Acknowledge God In All Ways

We acknowledge God and He directs our path. We acknowledge God as the mind of our being and we draw on It for wisdom, guidance, direction, and intelligence. We acknowledge God as the life of our being, and then we draw on that presence within for youth, vitality, strength, and the harmonious functioning of our body. We acknowledge God as the soul of our being out of which comes the purity of our human existence and our integrity, one to another. We acknowledge God as the very substance of our existence, even as the very substance of our body. Then we shall be expressing in every area the harmony of the substance which is God. "In all thy ways acknowledge" God. If there is a decision to be made, let us acknowledge God as the One who makes the decision, and let God make that decision in us and through us and for us. If there is to be a sale or a purchase, let God determine the advisability of it, the time of it, the place of it, and the amount of it. As we acknowledge Him as the source of our good, this inner wisdom will be reflected in our outer conduct.

Hezekiah who, when his people told him the enemy was coming and that all the armies of the aliens outnumbered them, said, "With him is an arm of flesh: but with us is the lord our God. . . And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah." This is important: they "rested" in his word. They did no more arguing: they did no more lighting of candles: they just rested in his word, and then the enemy fought among themselves and destroyed themselves while Hezekiah's people rested in his word. Once you have acknowledged omnipresence, you have nothing more to do than to rest in the word. . . and if there is only one power, spiritual power, why should you fear a material condition? Why should you fear a human condition of any kind if there is only one power? Then rest in that Word.

If there is any real prayer at all, it is the prayer of recognition, the prayer of acknowledgment and realization. Prayer is not asking anything of God and prayer is not expecting anything of God, because if there is any place where God is not expressed in Its fulness, there must be some place outside of God, which could not be if the nature of God is infinite being. Infinite being includes all being and, therefore, here where you are, God is; here where he is, she is, or they are, God is. Should you then pray for God to do something or rather acknowledge that God's presence is the doing of it? Does God need to be reminded by you of what you need or what your family needs? Or are you to acknowledge that the omniscience of God-the all-wisdom-is the omnipotence of God-the all power-in the omnipresence of God-the hereness and nowness of God. God is functioning. Is not that enough of a prayer?

You may even feel good to know that there is no power against which to use God, nevertheless tomorrow, when you are facing the appearances of life, there will be that old temptation to reach out for God, to want God to do something to some evil. You have to train yourself to realize: "No, God, I released You last night. You go ahead and fulfill Yourself. You are about Your own business, and I know that there is nothing in heaven or on earth for which I need any power that is not already functioning. . . All the power necessary to maintain my life is already at work, and all I have to do is to acknowledge it. Acknowledge that God is fulfilling Itself. God's nature is to fulfill Itself as peace on earth and the divine grace in my life. I do nor pray for grace; I do not ask for grace: I acknowledge grace as God's means of fulfilling Itself on earth. God's means of fulfilling Itself on earth is the power of grace. When I acknowledge that and let myself be receptive, I will find It functioning in my life.

Loving The Christ Of Individual Being

Is there anything to fear when we begin to acknowledge that Christ lives in one another, that Christ lives in our enemy as well as in our friend, that Christ lives in the animal world, the vegetable world, and the mineral world? We cannot fear the Christ in anyone, and when we have acknowledged Christ in a person, we have lost our fear of him and we have begun to love our neighbor as ourselves.

The Christ, The Multiplier And The Healer

The function of the Christ is to multiply: to multiply the loaves and fishes, to multiply everything in your experience that needs multiplying. It is not my function or yours to multiply: it is the function of the Christ in you. Your acknowledgment of this and your realization of this lets the Christ perform Its function of multiplication.

The Mystical I

An Act Of Commitment Violating Spiritual Law Breaks The Rhythm

Every time we violate spiritual law, the rhythm [that forms and sustains creation] is broken, and we violate spiritual law every time that we do not acknowledge God as Omnipotence, Omniscience, Omnipresence, and every time that we do not love our neighbor as ourselves. . . [or] accept a mind other than the mind of God.

If we merely acknowledge our Christhood, instead of living out from that Christhood by an act, we at once set up a conflict within our own being that is far worse that if we had never heard of Christhood, because having heard of It, we must now live It.

Spirit Is The Creator Of All Being

Whether or not you acknowledge or recognize It, the spirit of God is always and ever with you, even though It is of no avail to you, because it is only through your awareness of It, your consciousness of Its presence, that It functions.

Reestablishing Our Unity With The Tree Of Life

Sometimes we feel that when we acknowledge God in us, or the Christ indwelling, we are indulging duality or twoness, but this is not true. It cannot be explained logically any more than God can be explained, but the truth is that this *I* within us. . . is a the actually the Self of our being.

You bring this I into tangible expression only in the degree of your conscious awareness of it. There must be action; there must be conscious action, conscious recognition. "Turn yourselves, and live ye. . . In all thy ways acknowledge him and he shall direct thy paths. . . Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee.". . . And as your consciousness is active in truth, with truth, through truth, you will find that the truth, active in your consciousness, becomes the very fabric of the new life.

We Recognize Good An Evil In Human Experience

While it is true that humanly we seem compelled to acknowledge the limitations of good and evil, we must recognize that Consciousness does not embody within Itself qualities or quantities of good or evil, or of limitation.

Righteous Judgment

Humility means acknowledging that whatever of divine qualities you have, they are not something you have created for yourself: they are something given to you as a gift of God.

Sooner of later you must be willing to put off this "I" that is full of earthly errors, full of resentments, injustices, inequalities, and declare within yourself, "I am ready to assume my true identity. I am ready to awaken to the light of my own being. I am willing to accept the Master's statement that I am to call no man on earth my father, but acknowledge divine sonship for myself."

You do not love yourself until you acknowledge your true identity. You are not supposed to love your human self, because even when your human self is good, it is not very good.

Love And Joy, The Fruitage Of Contemplation

The same Spirit that raised up Jesus Christ from the dead is within you. You do not get It: you acknowledge It, recognize It, and let It flow. It is your dwelling in the consciousness of Its presence, your acknowledging Its presence within you, your communing in your silent moments with it that brings It more and more into manifestation.

From Law To Grace
I Say Unto You

So it is with us, even if we begin by realizing that God is our wisdom, our supply, and God is our this, that, or the other thing, and then forget to continue acknowledging our Source and instead claim it and use it as if it were our own, often what we do is to deplete and exhaust that supply because in claiming anything as our own we thereby cut ourselves off from the Source, and such separation results in limitation.
